Burnt Offering (Leviticus 1) For the Atonement of sin	Male Bull, Sheep, Goat. Turtledove or Pigeon	Transfer of sin through the laying of hands, and Sprinkling of blood around the Altar	All that was Burned		
Grain Offering (Leviticus 2) Gifts of thanks to the Lord	Flour mixed with Oil, salt and Frankincense. Unleavened bread made with Oil and salt. Roasted green heads of Grain with Oil and Frankincense.	Given to priest and handful is burnt on Altar	A handful of the mixture	Remainder of the Mixture	
Peace Offering (Leviticus 3) Well-being offering	Male or female animal	Transfer of sin through the laying of hands, and Sprinkling of blood around the Altar	Fat covering and within the entrails and back bone. Kidneys and fatty lobe attached to liver	Breast and Shoulder	Remainder of the Animal was a shared meal with God to be eaten on the day and non left for tomorrow (7:15)
Sin Offering (Leviticus 4) <u>Unintentional</u> sins	Young Bull (For Priests and Nation and its Rulers). Female Goat or Lamb (Common People)	Transfer of sin through the laying of hands, Blood sprinkled 7 times on veil (not for common people) and some on the horns of the altar (For common people) and remaining blood to be poured on the base of the altar. After removing God's portion the rest was burnt outside of camp where ashes are poured; But for the common people it was burnt on the altar	Fat covering and within the entrails and back bone. Kidneys and fatty lobe attached to liver	A portion of the meat was Boiled and eaten by the males among the Priest's (6:26-30)	
Trespass Offering (Leviticus 5) Removal of the Burden of Guilt	Female Lamb or Goat. Two Turtle doves or Pigeons (One as Sin offering and the other as Burnt Offering). Flour (as Sin Offering)	Sin offering Bird goes first. Its head is wringed off but the body is not divided. Blood sprinkled on the side and the rest is poured out on the base of the altar. The Burnt offering to be done as stated above	All that was Burned	All that remains
